**KY-KINS IS AN INNOVATIVE NEW PEER SUPPORT SYSTEM** designed to creatively support kin and fictive kin caregivers. The program connects caregivers to credentialed peer supporters with lived foster and kinship care experiences. Ultimately, KY-KINS seeks to foster a collaborative, dynamic network to help kin and fictive caregivers, and their families, thrive.

Kin and fictive kin caregivers who participate in the program will receive:

- Individualized support services from a credentialed peer supporter with lived experience
- Weekly check-ins and system navigation support
- Access to Kentucky Kinship Resource Center's virtual Kinship Training Catalogue
- Options to participate in KIN-VIP, a structured virtual support group network
