**Respite** is a time of rest or relief for people normally caring for children and youth. Respite provides a temporary break, improves family stability, and reduces the risk of abuse or neglect. This service may be provided in the persons' home or in another location and can be offered on an hourly, overnight, and/or emergency basis.
